

2019 MOUNTAIN SELECT CHARDONNAY

The 2019 Chardonnay Mountain Select has a relatively restrained, soft-spoken nose of fresh pears, white peaches and applesauce with hints of baking bread, lemongrass and toasted almonds. The medium- to full-bodied palate has a lovely creaminess to the texture with a quiet intensity of fresh stone fruit and savory layers, finished with a burst of freshness. - *November 5, 2020*

Lots of classy white peach, citrus, white flowers, and subtle minerality emerge from the 2019 Chardonnay Mountain Select. Coming from the Atlas Peak region, it's medium-bodied and has a fresh texture, nicely integrated acidity, and a clean finish. This is a beautiful, satisfying Chardonnay to drink over the coming 2-4 years. - *January 27, 2021*

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
